Le drapeau britannique s'appelle "The Union Jack". Il est formé de trois croix superposées qui résument l'histoire du pays. Les trois croix sont:


- La croix de St Georges (rouge sur fond blanc), symbole de l'Angleterre.



The Story of Thanksgiving

In 1620, hundreds of **Pilgrims** left England on a boat called the **Mayflower** to go to America.

They came in winter and lot of them died of cold and hunger.

Next spring, **Indians**, who lived there since a long time, helped the pilgrims by showing them where to fish, hunt and plant corn. To thank the Indians for helping them, the pilgrims organized a big party in autumn.

Every year, they continued to share a meal once a year.

How do American people celebrate Thanksgiving?

Thanksgiving is celebrated each year on the 4th Thursday of November in the United States.

This is a family party. All the family members share a big meal, play American football and watch the Thanksgiving parade on television. On Thanksgiving day, we cook all day long to prepare the traditional lunch : roast **turkey** with cranberry sauce, **corn** and **sweet potatoes**. For dessert, there are three traditional pies: the **pumpkin pie**, the **apple pie** and the **pecan pie**.

Each year, the president of the USA pardon one turkey: it won't be killed for Thanksgiving.
